Math*A*Thon

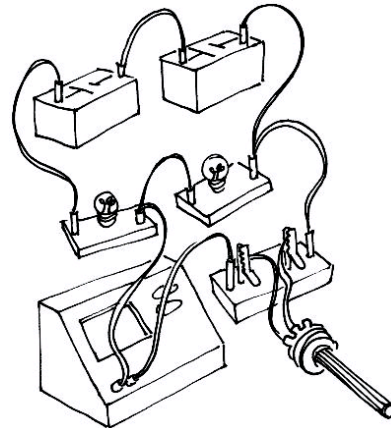
