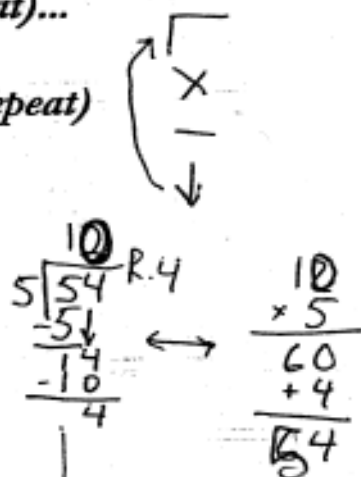


Long Division - "...The Song That I Must Sing..."
